



Call for Artists

The Woodlands Arts Council's 2018 Student Art Scholarships

We invite public, private, and home-schooled Juniors and Seniors to participate in our Annual Student Art Scholarship competition. The Woodlands Arts Council wants to give students the opportunity to exhibit their work and offer financial assistance towards their higher education. We are asking students to participate and submit in one of the following art categories: painting, drawing, mixed media 2D, mixed media 3D, digital art, and photography.

These works will be exhibited in a specially-curated exhibition at Market Street during the duration of March. Each student work will be judged by a panel of professors and artists from the greater Houston area. This exhibition will feature the student's creativity, and their artist's statement. This statement should follow the proper guidelines, which includes an italicized title, medium of the work, dimension of the work, along with a short paragraph about the work.

It is mandatory for each student whom is participating in this year's competition to submit an online application prior to the March 2nd submissions. We are asking students to complete their online application by February 28, 2018 and submit their works to us in person March 2, 2018. If you fail to do the online application, your work will not be considered in this years Scholarship opportunity. The winners from each category will be featured in the Student Art Scholarship booth at this year's 2018 Woodlands Waterway Arts Festival.
