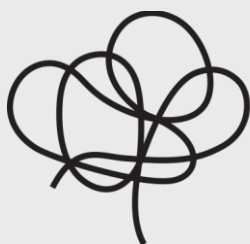
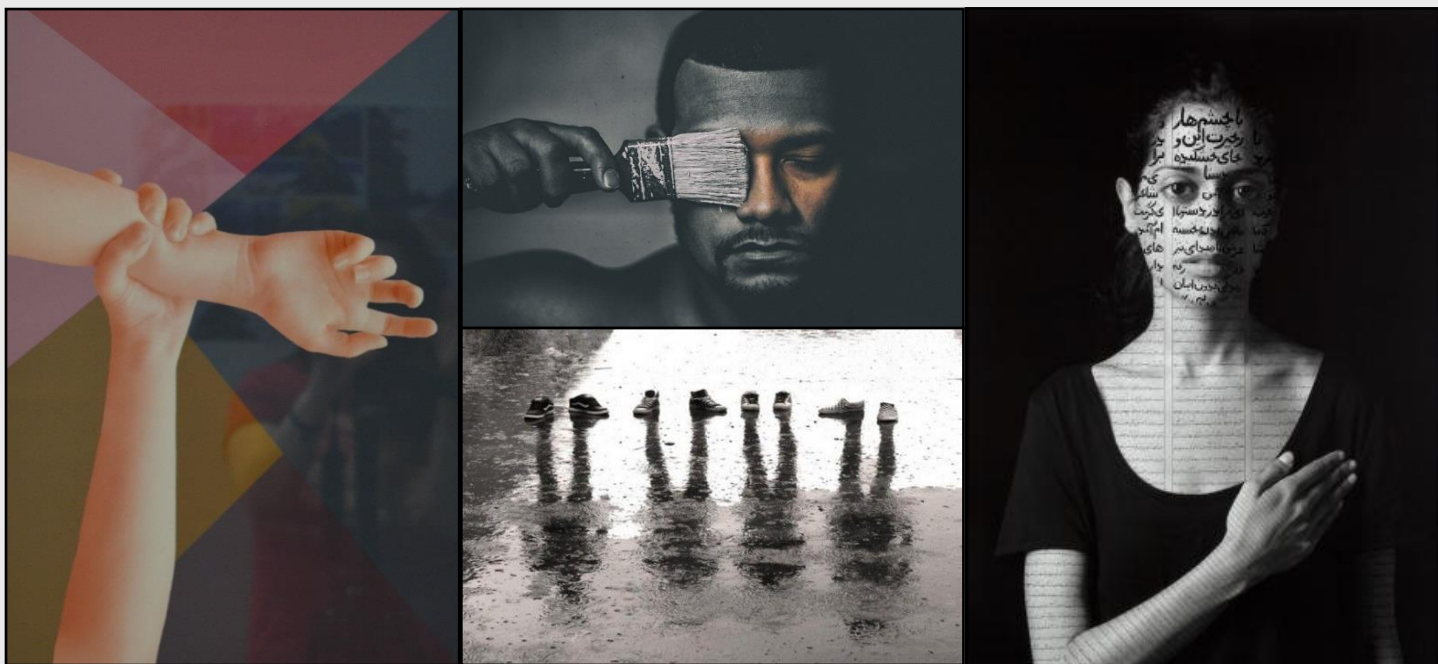
Contest Overview

The theme is “Identity.” By examining representations of the self, students are asked to create work specific to their own personal experiences and inner reflections. As a project focusing on the self, the challenge is to confront their position as both maker and subject.

Students are asked to think critically and conceptually about their identity possibly portraying themselves in abstract terms if they so choose. There are no conceptual or contextual requirements in the photographs, as each student is bound by their own subjective experiences of identity.

Your submission should be submitted digitally in a JPEG format and sent to photo@thewoodlandsartscouncil.org. The photo should be minimum of 4x6, and based on your artistic preference your image can be presented in either color or black and white. Once you have completed your work, as the artist you will need to submit a statement declaring either a definition or a short paragraph on what your piece means to you.
